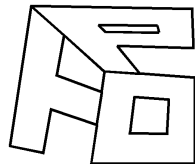

Best Presentation Award at ICCVG

- The papers of the best scientific level are preselected (reviews).
- The quality of presentation is the final criterion (recommendations of the session chairs).
- The winning paper(s) are selected by Programme Committee and TPO Governing Board.
- Award is granted to the young person who presented the paper.
- Award(s) and distinction(s) can be granted.
 - The distinction consists of a diploma.
 - The award consists of a diploma, and *the right to participate in the next ICCVG without the fee.*
- Results are announced in the Internet.

Best PhD Thesis of years 2018-2019

- The contest is open to authors of Ph.D. theses defended at Polish scientific institutions, in the domains of widely understood communication between the computer and its ambience by means of images
- Three reviewers (not members of the TPO Governing Board) prepare an initial ranking of submitted Ph.D. theses.
- Reviewers and the Governing Board of TPO discuss the theses.
- A voting is performed (using fuzzy sets).
- Award and distinction(s) can be granted.
 - The distinction consists of a diploma, and *the right to participate in the next ICCVG without the fee.*
 - The award consists of 4000 PLN, a diploma, and *the right to participate in the next ICCVG without the fee.*
- Results are announced in the Internet.
